Subject: Advertisement for the engagement of an all-inclusive consultancy contract under the 'ITTO-BMEL Teak Project Phase II' on a contractual basis at ICFRE- Institute of Forest Genetics and Tree Breeding (ICFRE-IFGTB), Coimbatore.

Assignment Title: Consultant #4: Efficient Teak Wood Transportation and Processing.

The ITTO project aims to significantly improve the production of high-quality timber from teak and other valuable species' (OVS) plantations established by smallholders and communities in the Asia-Pacific and West Africa. This will be achieved by promoting policies to secure high-quality planting stock, adopting best silviculture practices, providing access to financing to promote longer rotations, adding value, and improving timber legality. The project is looking for a consultant in India to support the data collection efforts for the wood transportation and processing studies.

To implement the ITTO Teak Project in India effectively, **Consultant #4: Efficient teak wood transportation and processing**, will be recruited to take responsibility for enhancing the capacity of local communities and relevant agencies on efficient teak round-wood harvesting through a series of training sessions and field works.

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Qualifications and principal tasks of Consultant # 4: Efficient teak wood transportation and processing are as follows.

1. Qualifications

- Post-graduate degree (MSc) in Agriculture/Forestry with Extension and communication
- Knowledge of the scope for crop diversification, and basic understanding on wood processing or forest technology
- A minimum of 5 years of working experience in the evaluation of programmes that are tailored to the needs of rural communities;
- Good analytical skills in evaluating determinants, deciding market adoptions and their role in promoting policy are preferred.
- Proven ability to work in teams with other experts and to communicate with local communities.
- Fluency in spoken and written English and Tamil/Malayalam.
- · Proven ability to work in teams with other experts
- Experience in developing test measures to assess market intelligence is an advantage

2. Principal Tasks

The principal tasks of Consultant #4: Efficient teak wood transportation and processing is to take overall responsibility to enhance the capacity of local communities and relevant agencies on efficient teak round-wood harvesting through a series of training sessions and field works. In addition, the consultant will produce and disseminate outreach and training materials on the conservation and sustainable management of teak and other valuable species plantations in line with the outcomes of the project.

The specific functions and responsibilities will include:

- Prepare a program for a five-day group training, including classroom
 presentations/discussions and field demonstrations on 1) minimizing
 harvesting loss, efficient transport and processing of teak round-wood, 2)
 equipment maintenance, waste disposal and storage of forest products that
 are tailored to the needs of rural communities and has the objective to
 improve efficiency, product quality and product design.
- Assist in the capacity building program for researchers, scientists and local communities, as and when required.
- Assist in other activities assigned by the National Coordinator.
- Work with Consultant#4 for other country Component to compile all results and findings of each training event, incl. recommendations for follow-up actions, in a technical project report in the English language to be submitted to the National Coordinator.

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 Available to provide recommendations and advises to National Coordinator, PTC members.

3. Duration

The duration of the assignment is three person-months (effort), from 1 January 2025 to 31 December 2026.

4. Honorarium

There will be a package payment of USD 6,000.00 (INR equivalent as per the prevailing rates). Using this honorarium, the consultant may hire additional staff to support the above tasks. Payment will be made in four instalments based on the milestones prescribed.

5. Deliverables

The consultant should submit the following outputs to the National Coordinator and the Principal Investigator:
