## Lecture on "Biomolecules - Gene in the biological system " and 'LiFE Mission' Organized by ICFRE- IFGTB

Dr A. Balasubramanian, Scientist B, of Plant Biotechnology division ICFRE- IFGTB delivered a lecture on "Biomolecules - Gene in the biological system" 08.12.2023 to Oxford Modern Matriculation School, Tiruppur on 08.12.2023. In total of 110 students and five staff were participated in the event. In his lecture he briefed about the hierarchy of life which starts from atom to population. The speaker elaborated about bio-molecule and elemental composition of human body like oxygen, carbon, hydrogen, nitrogen, calcium, phosphorous, potassium, sulfur, sodium, chlorine, magnesium and others. He pointed that carbohydrate, lipids, protein, nucleic acid are major source of energy. He highlighted top 10 foods having highest in glucose which is the energy storage of the cell. He added about the DNA and RNA which is said to be the central dogma of life. He finally concluded to the students to take more food for more energy with fruits and vegetables and other nutritional advice was given. The students were very interactive.
