Report on visit of Forest Guards trainees to ICFRE-IFGTB on 13.03.2024

As a part of the training programme, 60 Forest Guard trainees from Forest Training School, Vaigai Dam, Madurai, visited ICFRE-IFGTB on 13.03.2024. Dr. S. She explained the advantages of root trainer over poly bags in clonal technology





Smt. Shanthi, CTO explained about the Vegetative Multiplication Garden and different steps involved in clonal technology being involved in *Casuarina*, *Eucalyptus*, *Melia*, *Cadamba*, *Ailanthus*, etc.

Later on, the trainees were exposed to TC-Teak, recently released by ICFRE-IFGTB for fast growth and higher productivity. Smt. Shanthi explained about the advantage of TC-Teak *viz.*, fast growth, clear bole, short rotation, higher productivity, etc. compared to seed origin.
